Centris Employees Participate in Build-A-Rocker

OMAHA, Neb. – Employees from all **Centris Federal Credit Union** branches will participate in Build-A-Rocker on Friday, September 23. This is the second companywide team building event this year. Build-A-Rocker is a charity team building event where all staff work together to build rocking chairs and a few benches for licensed assisted living facilities in our communities.

"Staff members are assigned to 16 teams of 9 people with employees at our headquarters office randomly assigned to a team," said Dawn Gonzales, Vice President of Community Relations. "The rockers will take about 40 minutes to build and it's a great way for our employees to work together and give back to the communities we serve."

While the project began earlier this week for some branch locations, the majority of teams will meet on Friday for the Build-A-Rocker event. "The activity is not mandatory, but employees had such a good time building tricycles and bicycles in the spring that they are looking forward to this new challenge this week. In May, Centris employees built over 30 bicycles, tricycles and wagons and donated them to area non-profit day care centers," Gonzales said.

Rockers will be donated to the following organizations: Eastern Nebraska Veteran's Home; Florence Home; Royale Oaks Assisted Living; and House of Hope Assisted Living and Memory Care.
