Centris Federal Credit Union to Host Groundbreaking for New Branch Build at 66th & Ames Avenue

OMAHA, Neb., - For 13 years, Centris Federal Credit Union has operated a branch located at 48th Ames Avenue. Today, the credit union announced they have started construction on a new, full-service branch at 66th and Ames Avenue. Once this new branch location is open and operational, the existing Centris branch will close. The expected completion of the new building is late 2025.

A groundbreaking ceremony for the new branch will be held on Thursday, September 12, 2024, from 8:15 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. at 6572 Ames Avenue.

The Centris Ames Avenue branch is a staple in the Omaha community. "We are proud to see the steady growth of our membership at this branch and, because of this, we are excited to offer our members a location that will have more space, improved parking and drive-thru flow to provide the best overall experience for our members," said Ann Helm, Centris executive vice president and chief experience officer.

Building the Ames branch at a new location will allow Centris to keep the current branch fully operational during construction, causing no interruption in service. "Our employees are excited about this project for our members who call the Ames branch their financial home," said Helm.
