## 13th Annual Nebraska Prostate Cancer Alliance "Cruisin' for a Cure" Car Show to Help Save Lives and Showcase Classic Cars

**OMAHA, Neb.** – The 13th Annual Nebraska Prostate Cancer Alliance Cruisin' for a Cure Omaha Car Show is returning to Centris Federal Credit Union headquarters on Sunday, September 21, at 13120 Pierce Street. The event, famously known as the "car show that saves men's lives," will offer a unique blend of classic and exotic cars and crucial health screenings.

Car enthusiasts can register their vehicles from 9 a.m. to noon, with the main show running from noon to 3 p.m. While there is no entry fee, donations are encouraged to support the Nebraska Prostate Cancer Alliance.

From 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., men aged 40 and older can receive a free PSA (prostate-specific antigen) blood test for prostate cancer screening. Medical personnel from Methodist Hospital will be on-site to perform the tests, and results will be mailed directly to participants.

"Early detection is a game-changer when it comes to prostate cancer," said Jeff Shapiro, vice president of the Nebraska Prostate Cancer Alliance Board of Directors. "When caught early, it significantly increases the chances of successful treatment and can lead to less invasive options."

Since its inception in 2011, the event has provided over 1,500 free PSA tests. Last year alone, 148 men were tested, and 14 were notified of elevated scores, enabling them to seek follow-up medical care.

Centris Federal Credit Union is proud to be the presenting sponsor for the 13th consecutive year. To date, Centris has donated over \$35,000 to fund the free PSA tests.

All proceeds from the car show will directly benefit the Nebraska Prostate Cancer Alliance's mission of raising awareness and providing support.
